

Dear O'Hara Parents,

Fox Chapel Area School District students, grades K - 5, are invited to participate in the annual **Math Pentathlon Games**. Math Pentathlon is a wonderful way to build gamesmanship and math skills in a fun and structured environment. Kids who enjoy board games, learning, and competing with friends will love Math Pentathlon! Our Math Pentathlon program involves six practice sessions on Thursday afternoons starting January 18<sup>th</sup>, with a district-wide Game Day on Saturday, March 3<sup>rd</sup> at Dorseyville Middle School. This program is only possible through the support of parent volunteers; if you would like your child to participate, PLEASE plan to help (see below.)

**Student Requirements:**

- All O'Hara Students are eligible to participate
- Students should strive to attend all six practice sessions. Although Game Day is not required, it is a lot of fun and gives the kids a great sense of camaraderie and achievement
- Parents of participating students should plan on picking their children up promptly at 4:45 pm in the auditorium, accessed via the middle doors by the loading dock on the side of the building.
- Registration Fee and Registration Form MUST be received by January 12<sup>th</sup>. NO LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- Registration Form is attached to this email. Completed forms and the \$35 Registration Fee (checks only - made payable to O'Hara PTO) should be sent to the PTO Mailbox, attention Marcy Kaufman, by January 12<sup>th</sup>. The fee covers the expense of game materials, medals and t-shirts. Scholarship funds are available through Nurse Grove and/or Mrs. Squeglia.

**Parent Volunteers Requirements:**

- Participating students MUST have a parent volunteer commit to assist for at least two Thursday practice sessions two sessions in a row would be preferable since we play each game for two weeks). Volunteers should read the emailed game rules for the assigned game before assisting on practice day and plan to help kids learn the games.
- Parents can also help by being a **Division (Grade) Leader** (one parent-leader needed for each grade to learn the games and teach them to the children each week) or as a **Game Day Parent** (five parents needed for Game Day)
- All parent volunteers are REQUIRED to have clearances on file and be approved to volunteer at school by having a badge in the front office.

**Schedule:**

- Practice Days will take place on January 18<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>, February 1<sup>st</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>, and March 1<sup>st</sup> from 3:40 until 4:45pm. There is NO practice on February 15 due to the half day.
- Practice sessions will start in the cafeteria and then move to classrooms by grade.
- Game Day will occur Saturday, March 3<sup>rd</sup> at Dorseyville Middle School. Schedule TBA.

## Math Pentathlon 2018 Registration Form O'Hara Elementary School

Math Pentathlon is a great opportunity for students grades K through 5 to develop math skills, gamesmanship and problem-solving abilities while playing fun games with the support of parents.

- **Practice Days** will be on six Thursdays (**January 18 through March 1, excluding February 15**) from **3:40 pm to 4:45 pm** (pickup in auditorium via middle door off rear parking lot). Attendance at all six sessions is encouraged.
- **Game Day** will be held on Saturday, March 3, 2018. O'Hara Mathletes will join students from all Fox Chapel Area elementary schools to participate at Dorseyville Middle School. This is not a competition – all participants will be honored. While participation in Game Day is not required, it is strongly encouraged. (Specific times for each grade to be announced later.)
- **Parent Volunteers** – Each registered student is required to have a parent volunteer who will learn the games and attend at least two Practice Days (preferably two weeks in a row since we play each game for two weeks.) All volunteers need to have clearances on file and a volunteer badge in the O'Hara Office.
- **Talk with your students to make sure THEY want to participate. Students are expected to stay on task during the practice sessions.**
- **Registration** – Please complete the lower portion of this form and return it to O'Hara Office with \$35, payable to O'Hara PTO, for each student participant by January 12th. Late registrations will not be accepted.
